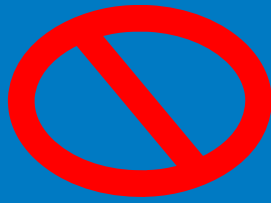


# TOP 10 things to keep out of your bin.



# WTF



Plastic bags can only be recycled through our ReSTORE program. You can find collection boxes for your bags at most grocery stores.



Napkins, paper towels & toilet paper are already too low a grade of paper to be recycled, & can pose health hazards.



Plastic caps are not the same type of plastic as the bottles & are not recyclable in RI. Taking them off also reminds you to empty the bottle first.



Paper and foam alike, disposable coffee cups are not accepted for recycling. Prevent waste all together & bring your own mug.



Bottles and jugs should be emptied of liquids before placing in your blue bin. Place the cap in the trash.



Greasy pizza boxes & other paper materials with food residues are not accepted for recycling.



When haulers see anything in plastic bags, they have been trained to treat them as trash. We need loose recyclables at our Materials Recycling Facility.



Containers that held hazardous waste such as automotive fluid or pesticides must be treated specially. Call 942-1430 ext. 241 more information.



Plastic jugs & bottles numbered with #1 and #2 are the ONLY plastics that go in your blue bin. Other shapes of #1 and #2 plastic & all #3-7 go in the trash.



Paper packaging designed for your freezer or fridge is treated in a way that prevents break-down in the recycling process. These belong in the trash.
